8. Student Loan Default Rates and Other Consumer Information

The latest default report by the Federal Student Aid office of the United States Department of Education provides load default data. The most recent data available is for the years 2015, 2016, and 2017.

Default rates by year: 2015 – 9.6% (n=115) 2016 – 7.6% (n=84) 2017 – 3.8% (n=45)
