- (1.) Any student who receives transfer credit for a mathematics course toward the fulfillment of the LAC (Liberal Arts Core) requirement in mathematics, nor credit for a course equivalent to Math 099, but does not have a SAT and/or ACT score (less than five years old) will be accepted according to the following scale:
- \* SAT Math = 440- 480 (ACT Math = 17-18): Bridge Program Math acceptance; current Bridge Program policies apply. (Note: The SAT scores are based on the redesigned SAT.) The student may be placed into a 100 level math course after achieving a sufficient score on the math placement exam.
  - \* SAT Math = 490- 800 (ACT Math = 19-36): Regular acceptance with regards to mathematics, regardless of high school record. Math placement exam is required. (Note: The SAT scores are based on the redesigned SAT.)
